- 1 Carta Vieja Sauvignon Blanc Chile £16.95**  
A delicious dry Sauvignon Blanc from the Loncomilla Valley in Chile with excellent gooseberry fruit flavours.
- 2 Carta Vieja Chardonnay Chile £16.95**  
An elegant, unoaked Chilean white that is packed with clean peach and citrus fruit flavours.
- 3 Pinot Grigio Matra Hills Hungary £16.95**  
Classic dry white with typical greengage fruit flavours from the beautiful vineyards of northern Hungary.
- 4 Hidden Bay Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand £20.95**  
An excellent refreshing Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with a typical grapefruit and elderflower bouquet.

## Red Wine

- 5 Carta Vieja Cabernet Sauvignon Chile £16.95**  
A delightful mellow red from the Maule valley with full blackcurrant flavour and a long smooth finish.
- 6 Dry River Shiraz Australia £16.95**  
A rich red made from Australia's leading red grape, the Shiraz, full of rich damson fruit on the palate.
- 7 Rioja Monte Haro Spain £19.95**  
A soft, elegant Rioja with good red fruit flavours from Bodega Paternina in Haro, the epicentre of Rioja.

## Rosé Wine

A clean, refreshing wine with lovely tropical fruit flavours from the renowned Trentham Estate in New South Wales.

A hand crafted, high quality Marlborough Sauvignon with typical gooseberry and elderflower fruit flavours.

A highly acclaimed Chablis which is crisp and elegant from an excellent vintage with pleasing maturity.

A classic, Côte d'Or Burgundy with complex integrated oak and subtle white peach fruit on the palate.

## Claret

<b>60</b>	<b>Domaine du Gouyat - Bergerac</b>	<b>09/10</b>	<b>£18.50</b>
Made by top Dordogne grower, Serge Dubard, this claret-style red is made predominately from the Merlot grape.			
<b>61</b>	<b>Château Nardou 'Cuvée Bois Meyney' - Bordeaux</b>	<b>09/10</b>	<b>£19.95</b>
A Merlot-dominated claret displaying a typical Bordeaux blend with succulent fruit and elegant tannins.			
<b>62</b>	<b>Cadet de Claymore - Saint-Émilion</b>	<b>07</b>	<b>£26.50</b>
A well made red from Lussac-St-Émilion which is full of blackcurrant fruit and a hint of liquorice.			
<b>63</b>	<b>Château de Beauregard - Graves</b>	<b>06/07</b>	<b>£28.95</b>
A wonderfully elegant, estate-bottled Claret from the Graves region just to the south-west of Bordeaux.			
<b>64</b>	<b>Château La Croix Romane - Lalande de Pomerol</b>	<b>09</b>	<b>£39.95</b>
Complex and well-structured, this full, smooth red comes from the right-bank Lalande de Pomerol region.			
<b>65</b>	<b>Château Lamour - Saint-Émilion Grand Cru</b>	<b>08/09</b>	<b>£42.50</b>
A delicious Saint Émilion Grand Cru that offers great value for money for this top class claret.			
<b>66</b>	<b>Amiral de Beychevelle - St Julien</b>	<b>06/07</b>	<b>£57.95</b>
The second wine of Beychevelle, this is a lightly perfumed, elegant and open wine with lots of dark fruit.			

## Burgundy

<b>70</b>	<b>Bourgogne Pinot Noir - Domaine Dubois</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>£22.95</b>
This soft, stylish Pinot Noir comes from the excellent Raphael Dubois whose cellars are in Nuits St Georges.			
<b>71</b>	<b>Beaujolais 'Château de Pizay'</b>	<b>09/10</b>	<b>£22.95</b>
From the beautiful Château de Pizay - one of the top Beaujolais producers - comes this delightful soft Gamay.			
<b>72</b>	<b>Fleurie 'Château des Labourons'</b>	<b>07/08</b>	<b>£28.95</b>
A cru Beaujolais of distinction with feminine characteristics, hints of violets and a silky finish.			
<b>73</b>	<b>Nuits-Saint-Georges - Domaine Dubois</b>	<b>06/07</b>	<b>£47.95</b>
A classic Pinot Noir that has masses of red berry fruit flavour and underlying spice.			

## Rhône

<b>80</b>	<b>Côtes du Rhône - La Chapelle du Marin</b>	<b>09/10</b>	<b>£19.95</b>
A gentle, fruity, medal-winning red from this Southern French Appellation that is full of complex red fruit.			
<b>81</b>	<b>Crozes-Hermitage - Cave de Tain</b>	<b>07/08</b>	<b>£31.95</b>
A superb red from the Northern Rhône made from the Syrah grape that is redolent of blackcurrants and spice.			
<b>82</b>	<b>Châteauneuf-du-Pape - 'Les Galets Rouge'</b>	<b>07/08</b>	<b>£39.95</b>
A well balanced, rich wine that has been aged in oak vats for 18 months to develop good fruit and tannins.

# Champagne

- 90 Champagne Nominé Renard Brut** £31.95  
Dry, elegant champagne from a small grower. Recently voted one of England's top 3 non-vintage champagnes.
- 91 Champagne Nominé Renard Rosé** £39.95  
From a small grower just outside Epernay comes this lovely, dry, delicate rosé champagne.
- 92 Champagne Joseph-Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut** £47.95  
A soft, fruit driven champagne made by a small family house with a biscuity nose and a fine mousse.
- 93 Champagne Pol-Roger - White Foil Brut** £58.50  
A perfectly balanced champagne with elegance and finesse that was the reception drink at the Royal Wedding.
- 94 Champagne Bollinger - Special Cuvée** £69.95  
A big, biscuity Champagne from the famous House of Bollinger in the village of Ay, still family-owned today.
- 95 Champagne Gosset Grande Rosé** £85.00  
Possibly the world's greatest rosé champagne and winner of a coveted 'Coup de Coeur' in the Guide Hachette.
- 96 Champagne Dom Pérignon 2000/02** £185.00  
Dom Pérignon is said to have exclaimed 'come quickly, I am drinking to the stars' with his first taste of champagne.
- 97 Champagne Louis Roederer 'Cristal' 2002** £205.00  
Roederer Cristal was created for Tsar Alexander II in 1876 and is as good today as it always was.

## Sparkling Wines

- 100 Prosecco** £19.95  
A delicate, lightly sparkling white wine from north eastern Italy made from the eponymous Prosecco grape.
- 101 Castillo Perelada Brut** £21.50  
A top quality Cava from the Rolls-Royce of Cava houses - Castillo Perelada - made by the champagne method.
- 102 Crémant de Bourgogne Rosé** £25.95  
From just south of the Champagne region, this delicious pink fizz is champagne in all but name and better than many!

Dirk's Ruby is an expressive port of great character, packed with red cherry fruit flavours.

<b>111 Niepoort LBV</b>		<b>£42.95</b>
	<b>50cl glass</b>	<b>£7.50</b>

This unfiltered LBV is a classic: unfiltered, it has massive mocha/damson richness. Outshines many a vintage port.

<b>112 Niepoort's Vintage 1999</b>		<b>£85.00</b>
<b>'Quinta do Passadouro'</b>	<b>50cl glass</b>	<b>£10.50</b>

A deep and intense vintage port, foot-trodden in lagares and made organically, giving wonderful purity of fruit.

## Half Bottles

### White

<b>120 Domaine du Gouyat - Bergerac Sec</b>	<b>£10.95</b>
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A delicious, dry white made predominately from the Sauvignon Blanc by the Dubard family at Ste-Foy-la-Grande.

### Red

<b>121 Domaine du Gouyat - Bergerac Rouge</b>	<b>£10.95</b>
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Made by top Dordogne grower, Serge Dubard, this claret-style red is made predominately from the Merlot grape.

<b>122 Château la Claymore - Lussac Saint-Émilion</b>	<b>£19.95</b>
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A well made red from Lussac-St-Émilion which is full of blackcurrant fruit and a hint of liquorice.
